

Mirror Care and Maintenance

Crystal recommends the following;

- Keep bathrooms well ventilated during showers to avoid condensation that can run and pool at the edge of the mirror.
- Never use ammonia-inclusive cleaners on your mirrors
- Never spray cleaners directly on a mirror. Spray on a rag first, then wipe.
- Always protect the edge from excessive moisture. If your mirror sits directly on a vanity top, then ensure that the bottom edge of the mirror is kept dry.
- Glass can also be cleaned with a clean cloth dampened with water only. Newspaper can then be used to clean off any lint.

'Edge Creep' that occurs in mirrors is the result of being exposed to moisture, oils or chemicals that have corrupted the edge and separated the layers of paint at the back of the glass.

Oxidation often occurs in mirrors that have backing paint that includes copper.

Crystal do not use copper based paints to back its mirrors.
